As our organization celebrates its 27th year, we are proud that we have never lost sight of our mission, and yet we continue to evolve and change.

We are extremely excited about the new ventures at our Dix Hills location with regard to our Early Head Start and Head Start partnerships, our new child day care program along with our newly approved integrated option for children with special needs.

At our East Setauket location our program was just awarded a 5 Star Active rating from Quality Stars NY, demonstrating our excellence and achievement.

Here at Alternatives For Children our mission is to provide those comprehensive, quality programs to help each child reach his or her potential. We expect to be accountable for governmental reimbursement, we also need to be able to have the funding that allows us to do what we do best! I will keep you informed of this ongoing situation, as we may need the help of you, our supporters, parents, and staff to reach out to NYS government officials on our behalf to effect change.

We have a good news! Alternatives For Children in conjunction with Teg - an innovative learning company is providing professional development online training in which teachers and therapists will gain broad knowledge and skills in educational technology to utilize for their students.

The training covers technology and its educational uses and applications for I-Pad and Smartboard for preschoolers. Training sessions are fully online and staff can attend and earn credit during live scheduled sessions or through archived course material.

Staff will need to commit to at least 5 hours of training a month or total of 30 hours for 6 months accumulated (outside of work). They also must be willing to share any knowledge that they have learned with other staff members that can be used in our school setting. This is surely a win-win opportunity!

It all began with a simple letter . . .

Last year, Girl Scout Cadette Troop 783 from Candlewood Middle School, under the guidance of Troop Leader Maribeth Kramer, was focused on earning their Silver Award, the highest award a Girl Scout Cadette can earn. The Silver Award project is to be planned around identifying a need in the community and showing that even though the girls are just 12–13 years old, they can make a real impact in the world they live in. Maribeth, a resident of the Half Hollow Hills School District, had heard that we had moved into the former Chestnut Hill Elementary School and she and the girls decided to make Alternatives For Children and welcoming us to the neighborhood their project.

The girls proposal was to design and build a puppet theater, which could be used by the Speech and Occupational Therapists for skill development, or even for the children and teachers as a play opportunity.

The children, faculty and staff at Alternatives For Children are so grateful to have been the recipient of this wonderful puppet theater. Mr. William Ulrich Jr., Industrial Technology Teacher at Candlewood Middle School in the Half Hollow Hills School District was instrumental in helping the girls design and execute the puppet theater. Maribeth Kramer and the adult leaders of Troop 783 deserve so much credit for teaching the girls understanding and acceptance of all people through this project. It wasn't just about the puppet theater for the girls. It was working with other Girl Scout Troops making puppets that they donated; it was going out in the community to solicit donations of some really awesome puppets; it was coming to school and playing "make believe" and putting on puppet shows with and for the children. It was magical – these girls are just like the Blue Fairy in Pinocchio – they made puppets come alive!

Both of my children started at Alternatives For Children slightly over a year ago (toddler program and pre-school). Not only are they both thriving academically, but they equally love their teachers and school. The small class sizes ensure that each student gets the attention they need. I love the academics and environment in which my children are enveloped each day.

Yes, it is expensive, but it is so worth it! If they were in a traditional daycare setting, not only would their class sizes be larger, but they would not receive such a well-rounded education.
